## **BASIC BOOT MAKING**

We know we put this course on the first page, but we are adding more information here because we want you to have all seminar information on one page. An exciting, hands-on class, everyone makes a 14-inch, lined, cowboy boot with four rows of top-stitching. You choose the colors and you custom-fit the last.

The tuition for this two-week seminar includes lasts and leather for one pair of boots, *The Cowboy Boot Book* at the class, and the my Basic Bootmaking DVDs on boot making, including my "Fitting the Last" DVD.

You measure, make a pattern, design and sew the tops. Then learn real 'boot building techniques' of crimping, lasting, and bottoming with a leather welt, metal shank, and to build a stacked leather cowboy pitched heel. Students have the use of the shop, hand tools, and machines during class. Students take home their customized lasts and handmade boots. Keep learning with one-on-one seminars.

## **THE COWBOY BOOT KIT**

Students who want to make a second pair after class without buying too much leather, can buy a Cowboy Boot Kit. The Boot Kit makes your practice affordable, and it is the same good leather as we use for my shop customers. The kit includes all of the materials for one pair of boots. The Boot Kit starts at \$185.00, but you can choose specialty leathers, and or lasts for an extra charge. Some hand tools are needed for an extra fee. Please call with questions.

## **ONE-ON-ONE SEMINARS ON SPECIAL TOPICS**

### **ADVANCED BOOT TOP DESIGN**

Exotic leathers like reptile or fowl are more difficult to work with, but here you can learn to design and construct boots using the natural markings of exotic leathers. Ostrich, Crocodile, Alligator, Stingray are more difficult to last, but we do them, and also a triad boot design on a two-piece top.

### **VAMP & HEEL FOXING DESIGN**

A concise seminar on decorative foxing for toe box, heel counter, pull ears, and buckaroo vamp cover, One pair of boots is prepared by the student.

### **TOOLED LEATHER TOPS & HEELS**

Carved western, Sheridan-style cowboy boot tops, vamps and counter covers bring a premium price for skill and labor. Learn to select leather, layout/design, and to finish and preserve your leather. You will be carving, foxed toe and heel caps, and Buckaroo vamp. We also cover hanging lining, f at side seams, and carved heels. Students leave knowing fancy boot construction with new carving skills.

### **TWO-PIECE WELLINGTON BOOT**

The Wellington boot is part of the Calvary officer's uniform. It is more difficult to make because the front/top/vamp is one piece, and the back/top/counter cover is one piece. Use special crimp boards for this style, with quality leather. Wellingtons are' an elegant dress boot, with a high heel. For serious students who have made three pair of boots or shoes.

## **WESTERN MULES**

*Chick Boots* as boot makers call them, are actually "mules" a slip-on, high-heeled shoe worn by women with an exposed heel. Students learn to create cowboy boot style mules using traditional patterns of filigrees, inlays, top-stitching with carved designs.

## **LACE-UP PACKER BOOTS**

Using a properly fitted cowboy boot last, students learn to make a top pattern for the ever popular lace-up boot. Choose your own heel height, leather color and decoration.

## **LEATHER WORKING**

Learn to select the proper leather, design geometric patterns and construct and tool a variety of simple leather products. Also the use and care of carving tools, cutting and skiving techniques, wetting and forming methods to tool a book jacket, or bag, or a leather frame for a photo.

## **BOOT & SHOE REPAIR**

Learn to repair custom boots and factory boots using hand tools and machines for resoling and re-heeling. Top leather reconditioning, crack repair, stretching, resoling and heel building are covered. For an extra fee, The BOOT REPAIR DVD is ready!

## **MACHINERY REPAIR**

This seminar teaches the right way of rebuilding, maintenance and repair on machines used in a boot shop. We have a new repair DVD coming soon.
